You Will Need For Each Child

Background	1 turquoise rectangle	9"	x	12"
Snow	1 white rectangle	6"	x	9"
Hole	1 gray rectangle	1½"	x	6"
Body	1 brown rectangle	3"	x	4"
Head	1 brown rectangle	2"	x	3"
Ears	1 brown rectangle	¾"	x	1½"
Legs	1 brown rectangle	¾"	x	4"
Sun	1 yellow square	3"	x	3"
Rays	1 yellow rectangle	1¾"	x	2"
Cloud	1 gray rectangle	2½"	x	3"

Song
Scissors, glue, blue and black crayons, pencil

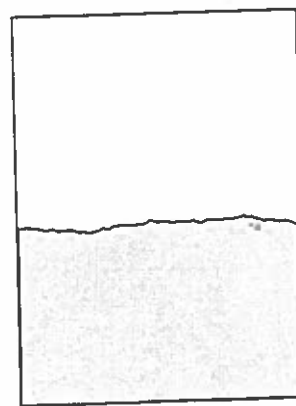


1.) Background: (turquoise rectangle)



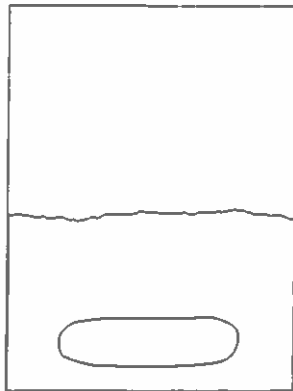
- Place the turquoise rectangle in a vertical position on the table

2.) Snow: (white rectangle)

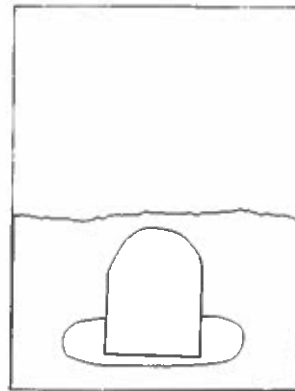


- Hold the rectangle in a vertical position; tear off a narrow strip of paper along one long side
(See TLC Cuts for "tearing" instructions)
- Put a dot of glue in each corner; glue the snow at the bottom of the turquoise rectangle with the torn side up

(larger gray rectangle)



(largest brown rectangle)

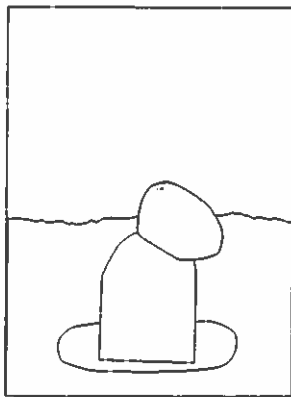


- Cut an oval
(See TLC Cuts for "oval cut" instructions)
- Glue the hole in a horizontal position as shown

- Hold the rectangle in a vertical position; cut off the top two corners and round
(See TLC Cuts for "hill cut" instructions)
- Glue the body in a vertical position overlapping the hole as shown

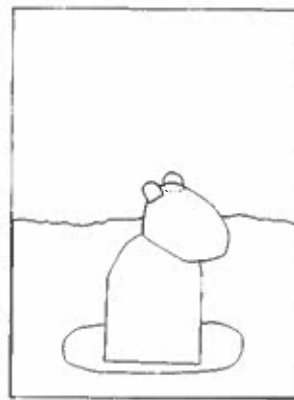
5.) Head:

(next to largest brown rectangle)



6.) Ears:

(smallest brown rectangle)

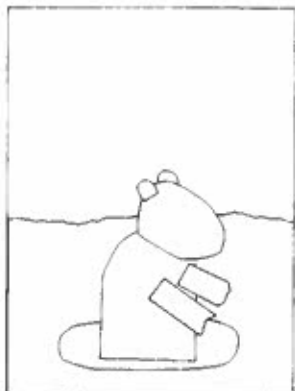


- Cut an oval
- Glue the head to the top of the body as shown

- Fold the rectangle in half so you can cut two ears at a time
- Hold the folded rectangle in a vertical position; cut off the top two corners and round; if the pieces are still connected cut apart on the fold line
- Glue the ears as shown

7.) Legs:

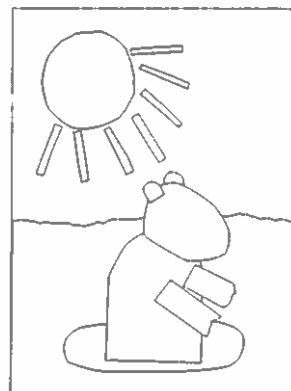
(long narrow brown rectangle)



- Fold the rectangle in half so you can cut two legs at a time
- Cut a wavy line along one end;
(See TLC Cuts for "wavy line" instructions)
if the pieces are still connected cut apart on the fold line
- Glue the legs as shown

8.) Sun/Rays:

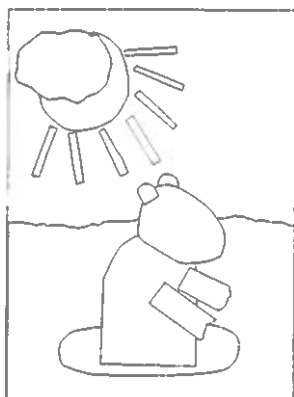
(yellow square and rectangle)



- Cut the yellow square into a circle
(See TLC Cuts for "circle cut" instructions)
- Glue the sun in the upper left corner as shown
- Hold the rectangle in a horizontal position and cut the piece crosswise into 7-8 narrow pieces
- Glue the rays around the sun as shown

9.) Cloud:

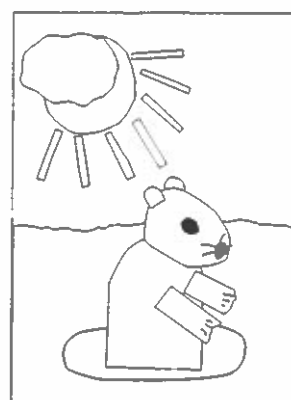
(smaller gray rectangle)



- Cut a wavy line around the outside edge of the rectangle
- Glue the cloud in a horizontal position overlapping the sun as shown

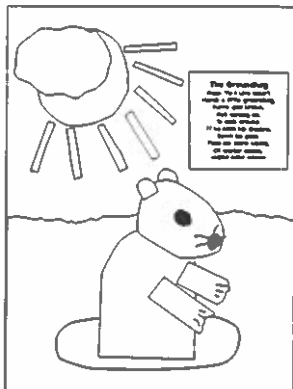
10.) Details:

(blue and black crayons)



- Use the the blue crayon to draw a line around the hole
- Use the black crayon to draw the groundhog's features
